Sheldon, Krebs Finish In Roxbury Land Trust Race Winners Circle

ROXBURY – Jeff Sheldon, 32, and Theresa Krebs, 43, added to their victory totals in the weekly Roxbury Road Race Series by winning their respective divisions in the fourth annual Roxbury Land Trust 3.0-miler.

Sheldon of Southbury was the top overall finisher for the 17th time this year, covering the layout, which began at the entrance to the land preserve on River Road and finisher near the pond at that open space parcel, in 17-minutes, 31-seconds – a 5:50-per-mile pace.

Ken Merrick, 43, who is leading the point standings for the season, was second in 17:59.

Krebs of Roxbury annexed the female title for the 20th time this year at Roxbury, as she took sixth place overall in 19:37.

The \$5-per-runner entry fee generated \$270 for the Roxbury Land Trust.

The series will resume Saturday, Sept. 29, at 8:30 a.m. with the 2.4-mile Ed Sandifer Handicap, which will start and finish near the Everett Hurlburt Community Park on Apple Lane. The course will include a trip down the steep hill on Chalybes Road.

The runners will take off on a staggered start, based on their ability. Results will be compiled for both their handicap and the actual times.

There will be a \$5 entry fee that can be paid that morning from 7 to 8:20. Proceeds will benefit Sandifer of Newtown, an 11-time champion of the race series who suffered a severe stroke in Aug. 2009.

After the race, he will be the featured guest during a breakfast that will be held at the community park.

The weekly races are sanctioned by the Roxbury Recreation Commission.
