

3-MILE RUN FOR A CURE TO AGAIN RAISE MONEY FOR CANCER RESEARCH

ROXBURY – The 14th annual 3.0-mile Run For A Cure will be held on Thanksgiving Day, Nov. 27, at the Roxbury Congregational Church to raise money for cancer research.

Last year's event raised more than \$2,000 combined for the cancer center at New Milford Hospital and the American Cancer Society's Relay For Life Shepaug Valley Chapter, as well as another \$400 for the Roxbury Road Race Series' stop-watch campaign.

Over the last 13 years, the race has generated nearly \$20,000 for area charities.

This year the \$10 entry fee, which can be paid that morning from 7:30 to 9:20 at the church, will benefit the two cancer research projects.

The .7-mile children's run will commence at 9 a.m. in front of the church. The walkers and strollers will take off on the 3.0-mile course at 9:15 a.m. and the runners will start at 9:30 on that loop, which will include a trip up the steep hill on Chalybes Road.

The event is sponsored by the church, the Roxbury Recreation Commission and the road race series.

The top overall male and female finisher will each receive a plaque.

Refreshments will be available.
