

# **3-MILE RUN FOR A CURE TO AGAIN RAISE MONEY FOR CANCER RESEARCH**

**ROXBURY – The 14<sup>th</sup> 3.0-mile Run For A Cure will be held on Thanksgiving Day, Nov. 26, at the Roxbury Congregational Church to raise money for cancer research.**

**The 2013 event raised more than \$2,000 combined for the cancer center at New Milford Hospital and the American Cancer Society's Relay For Life Shepaug Valley Chapter, as well as another \$400 for the Roxbury Road Race Series' stop-watch campaign.**

**During The Run For A Cure's 13 years, the race has generated nearly \$20,000 for area charities.**

**This year the \$10 entry fee, which can be paid that morning from 7:30 to 9:20 at the church, will again benefit the two cancer research projects.**

**The .7-mile children's run will commence at 9 a.m. in front of the church. The walkers and strollers will take off on the 3.0-mile course at 9:15 a.m. and the runners will start at 9:30 on that loop, which will include a trip up the steep hill on Chalybes Road.**

**The event is sponsored by the church, the Roxbury Recreation Commission and the road race series.**

**The top overall male and female finisher will each receive a plaque.**

**Refreshments will be available.**
