ROXBURY – The Roxbury Road Runners Club will raise money to assist victims in Texas from the devastation of Hurricane Harvey at a Thanksgiving Day Run.

Runners can register through an event invitation message on the Roxbury Races Facebook Page that will be posted starting Saturday, September 16. The field will be limited to the first 50 entries, so that it will be manageable.

The 3.1-mile event will be held on Thursday, November 23, 2017 at 9 a.m. starting and finishing near the Everett Hurlburt Community Park at 18 Apple Lane.

The entrants can pay the \$10 entry fee that morning from 7 to 8:40 at the community park. The proceeds will be donated through the American Red Cross.

The course will be marked with mile postings and directional arrow lawn signs. Refreshments will be available.

The Roxbury Road Runners Club sponsors a 38-race annual series on Saturday mornings, as well as the annual Roxbury Marathon and Roxbury Half Marathon.

If the race is postponed due to inclement weather, it will be run on Saturday, November 25, at 8:30 a.m. as part of the weekly Roxbury Road Runners Club series. Runners will be able to register that morning from 7 to 8:20
