

Deming, Masopust Win Judd's Bridge Jaunt

ROXBURY – Chris Deming and Alison Masopust turned in convention nomination-worthy performances to annex their respective titles in a 4.8-mile race at the Roxbury Road Races Club series.

Deming, 51, of Danbury was the overall winner for a third time in 2018 in the weekly races, crossing the finish line in 31-minutes, 22-seconds – a 6:32-per-mile pace.

Randy Watkins, 54, was second in 32:03 along the route Saturday, May 12, that included a trip along part of Judd's Bridge Road.

Masopust, 34, of Morris was third overall and scored her seventh triumph of the year in the women's division with a 32:12 clocking.

There were 41 finishers.

The series will resume on Saturday, May 19, at 8:30 a.m. with a 3.52-mile run that will include a trip up the long hill on Hemlock Road.

Runners can enter through the \$25 season membership or the \$2 weekly waiver fee. Youth runners can run for free after signing the weekly waiver.

The races, which are sanctioned by the Roxbury Recreation Commission, start and finish near the Everett Hurlburt Community Park at 18 Apple Lane.
