Roxbury Road Runners Club Series To Resume

The Roxbury Land Trust/Bill Burley MidSummer Championship is scheduled for Saturday, July 10, at 8:30 a.m. Instead of starting at the Everett Hurlburt Community Park at 18 Apple Lane, the race will start and finish near the Roxbury Land Trust preserve on River Road.

The series has honored the land trust since 2009. The event also is named after Bill Burley, who founded the races in 1977 and was the first head director of the series.

Runners can enter the race through the \$25 season membership. They also can participate by completing the weekly waiver form and paying \$2 if they have a timing chip and \$5 if they need to get a timing chip. Youth runners can enter for free after completing the weekly waiver.

The series will move back to the Everett Hurlburt Community Park on Saturday, July 17.

The races are sanctioned by the Roxbury Recreation Commission.
