Nihill, Levy Winners At Roxbury Harrier 3.52mile Event

ROXBURY – Joey Nihill of Southbury, a standout at the Taft School in Watertown, and Alana Levy, who began running in the Roxbury Road Runners Club series about 20 years ago as a middle school student, wore the championship crowns after a 3.52-mile race.

Nihill accelerated through the loop, which included a trip up the hill on Hemlock Road, in 19-minutes, 55-seconds – a 5:39-per-mile pace – on Saturday, May 29, to finish first overall.

Levy, who hails from Chappaqua, N.Y., was tops in the female division and second overall with a 21:44 clocking.
