ROXBURY – Steven Pack wore the championship derby after striding through a 3.7-mile course in 24-minutes, 24-seconds – a 6:36-per-mile pace – at the Roxbury Road Runners Club series.

Pack, 40, of Roxbury outlasted Mark Andrejczyk, 48, of Shelton – who placed second in the Saturday, October 23, event – with a 24:39 clocking.

Kateri Danay, 23, was third overall and captured the female division for the sixth consecutive race. She traveled through the route, which included a trip down the long incline along Ranney Hill Road – 26:40.

With less than a month and a half remaining to the season, David McNamara of New Haven tops the season standings with 754 points. Danay is second with 672 points and Lou Denaro stands in third place with 663 points.

The series will resume on Saturday, October 30, at 8:30 a.m. with the 3.5-mile Shepaug Trail race.
