Sheldon Conquers Moosehorn To Tally Fifth Roxbury Win Of 2022

ROXBURY – Jeff Sheldon posted his third consecutive victory and his fifth of the season at the weekly Roxbury Road Runners Club series by winning the grueling 9.9-mile Moosehorn Run.

The 42-year-old Southbury resident ran the route, which includes a trip up the steep hill on Moosehorn Road, in 1:06.29 – a 6:43-per-mile pace.

Kateri Danay, 24, of Waterbury was the first female finisher in the Saturday, June 4, event and took fifth overall in 1:23:01. It was her third straight victory in the women's division and her eighth in 2022 at the series.

The series will continue on Saturday, June 11, at 8:30 a.m. with a 3.9-mile run, which include a trip along a jeep trail.

Runners can compete through the \$25 season membership. They also can enter by completing the weekly waiver form. If they have a timing chip, the cost is \$2. If they do not have a chip the fee is \$5. Youth runners can participate for free after completing the weekly waiver form.

The races, which are sanctioned by the Roxbury Recreation Commission, start and finish near the Everett B. Hurlburt Community Park at 18 Apple Lane.
