Steven Pack of Roxbury was the first male finisher, placing second overall in 24:43.

The series will resume on Saturday, March 26, at 8:30 a.m. with a 3.1-mile course that will include a trip up and down the long hill along Hemlock Road.

Runners can enter through the \$25 season membership. They also can participate by completing the weekly waiver form. If they have a timing chip the cost will be \$2. If they don't have a chip the fee is \$5. Youth runners can compete for free after completing the weekly waiver form.

The races, which are sanctioned by the Roxbury Recreation Commission, typically start and finish near the Everett B. Hurlburt Community Park at 18 Apple Lane.
