Sheldon Scores Judd's Bridge Victory

ROXBURY – Jeff Sheldon, 42, of Southbury easily won an 8.2-mile race at the weekly Roxbury Road Runners Club series that included a trip along a dirt road to a wooden bridge.

Sheldon posted his 10th triumph of the season the series with a time of 55minutes, 51-seconds – a 6:49-per-mile pace – on the Judd's Bridge Road loop. He is a former two-time season champion at the series.

Alison Masopust, 38, of Morris won the female title for the 12th time in 2022. She was timed in 57:31 to place second overall at the Saturday, October 8, run. Masopust has garnered the women's season title three times.

The series will continue with a 3.52-mile race on Saturday, October 15, at 8:30 a.m. that will include a trip down the long hill on Hemlock Road.

Runners can enter through the \$25 season membership. They also can compete by completing the weekly waiver form. If they have timing chip, the fee is \$2. If they do not have a timing chip, the charge is \$5. Youth runners can compete for free after completing the weekly waiver form.

The runners will collect non-perishable food donations and unwrapped toys from November 5 through December 3. The food donations will go to the Roxbury Food Bank at the Roxbury Church of Christ and the toys will be delivered to the collection box at the Troop A state police headquarters in Southbury.
