McNamara Scores Hat Trick

Randy Watkins, 59, of New Milford placed second in 6:28 and Alison Masopust, 38, of Morris was the first female finisher and placed third overall in 6:30. It was her eighth triumph in 2022 in the women's division at the Roxbury Road Runners Club series.

Chris Deming, 55, of Danbury took fourth in 6:47 and Kateri Danay of Waterbury was fifth with a 6:55 clocking.

Deming, a former season champion, leads the 2022 standings with 853 points. Danay is second with 830 points.

The series will continue on Saturday, September 10, at 8:30 a.m. with an 8.7-mile race that will include a trip through the Battleswamp Preserve.
