Consalvo Makes It 11, Danay 10 Roxbury Wins In 2023

ROXBURY – Tommy Consalvo and Kateri Danay continue to dominate their respective divisions at the weekly Roxbury Road Runners Club series.

Consalvo, 25, of Brookfield posted his 11th overall victory on Saturday, August 12, by covering a challenging 7.2-mile course in 47-minutes, 58-seconds – a 6:37-permile pace.

Jeff Lipchus, 40, from the Sandy Hook section of Newtown, took second in 50:03.

Danay, 25, of Waterbury annexed her 10th triumph in the women's division for 2023 and placed 10th overall in the race with a clocking of 1:04.06 over the route, which included a trip up the steep hills on Mallory Road.

The series will continue with a 3.7-mile race on Saturday, August 19, that will include a trip down the steep hill on Chalybes Road and up the long incline along Hemlock Road.

Runners can enter through the \$25 season membership. They also can participate by completing the weekly waiver form. If they have a timing chip, the fee is \$2. If they do not have a timing chip, the cost if \$5. Youth runners and current and former first responders and members of the military can enter for free after completing the weekly waiver form.

The sixth annual Roxbury Thanksgiving Day Race will be run over a 3.1-mile loop on Thursday, November 23, at 9 a.m. Pre-registration is available through Ultra Sign-up at https://ultrasignup.com/register.aspx?did=105567.

The races, which are sanctioned by the Roxbury Recreation Commission, start and finish near the Everett B. Hurlburt Community Park at 18 Apple Lane.
