James Feather, 15, of Bridgewater was second in 1:15.56 in the Saturday, September 17, event, which included a trip in both directions on Judd's Bridge Road and Walke's Brook Road.

The series will continue on Saturday, September 23, with a 4.8-mile race that will include a trip in both directions along part of Judd's Bridge Road.

Runners can enter through the \$25 season membership. They also can participate by completing the weekly waiver form. If they have a timing chip, the fee is \$2. If they do not have a timing chip, the cost is \$5. Youth runners and current and former first responders and members of the military can compete for free after completing the weekly waiver form.
