## Wylden Abraham Annexes Second Roxbury Win Of 2025; Weiser Captures Women's Crown

ROXBURY – Wylden Abraham again took the blue ribbon.

The 16-year-old Roxbury resident won his second race of 2025 at the weekly Roxbury Road Runners Club series and made it four victories in the last five races dating to last year.

Abraham easily bested a competitive field on Saturday, March 15, over a 3.7-mile course with a clocking of 24-minuytes – a 6:29-per-mile pace.

Dwight Harris, 39, of Southbury placed second in 24:50 and Abraham's father, former New Milford High School boys' cross-country coach Mike Abraham was third in 26:28. Mike Abraham was the 2024 season champion at the Roxbury series.

Katie Weiser, 34, from the New Preston section of Washington took first place in the women's division for the second time in 2025. She was timed in 26:38, finishing fourth overall.

The series will continue on Saturday, March 22, at 8:30 a.m. with a 3.5-mile event that will include a trip down the long hill on Hemlock Road.

Runners can compete through the \$30 season membership. They also can participate by completing the weekly waiver form and paying \$5. Youth entrants and current and former first responders and current and former military members can run for free after completing the weekly waiver form.

The races, which are sanctioned by the Roxbury Recreation Commission, start and finish near the Everett B. Hurlburt Community Park at 18 Apple Lane.
